## Parental Requirements

- Make every effort to have your child at practice or games on time.
- Support and encourage your child to do their very best.
- Support the program by actively participating in fundraising activities and work-related improvement projects.
- Make every effort to attend general membership meetings held so that your voice may be heard in the proper forum.

## Rules of Conduct

- Adults should lead by example and show children that problems can be resolved without loud and abusive behavior. This behavior, as well as violence, should not be resorted to as a means of conflict resolution.
- Foul language in the presence of children will not be tolerated at any time by the Conway Community League. Also, verbal assaults or demeaning language directed towards coaches or players will not be tolerated.
- Public criticizing of coaches or officials will be discouraged as it impedes our goal of players learning proper respect for them.

## Player Requirements

The child/player will be accountable for their actions. The following actions will not be tolerated from the child/player: swearing at a coach, umpire, or teammate/players; arguing in the dugout or on the field with coaches, umpires or teammates/players; or, any disrupting of the game or team in any way.

## Protocol

Any parent/guardian or player who wishes to address a concern with a coach must do so AFTER a practice or game, and outside the presence of other players and parents. If the issue is not resolved, he/she may file a complaint with the proper Commissioner. The Commissioner may then submit it to the Board for resolution.

## Penalties

Parents who refuse to abide by these rules can be banned from attending practices or games and, in some circumstances; children may be removed from the program.

**“ZERO TOLERANCE” WILL BE ENFORCED.** This is at the coach's judgment. If he/she feels code of ethics has been violated, it will be brought to the board for proper disciplinary action(s). Once the board has ruled on the matter, all decisions are final.
