

Conway Community League
Standing Rules
2010 Season

1. The Board will regulate registration dates and fees.
2. Any subject or problem that develops will be settled at the discretion of the Board
3. Any manager or coach found guilty of any unsportsmanlike conduct shall answer to the Board. (i.e.: code of conduct forms signed by parents & players).
4. Umpires are in complete charge of each game. They shall recognize only one manager from each team.
5. The Concession Stand fee will be \$30.00 per family. The fee will be refunded to you after you have worked once in the concession stand. If for some reason you can not work your scheduled day, it is your responsibility to find a replacement. No one under the age of 18 can work in the concession stand.
6. Any person who still owes money or fees at the time uniforms are passed out will not receive their uniform until these fees are paid in full.
7. Any players quitting for any reason, after uniforms are ordered, will be refunded the registration fee minus the cost of the shirt and hat. Players will be allowed to keep the shirt and hat. If a player quits after the season has started, no refunds will be granted for any reason.
8. All equipment room keys and equipment must be returned to the Field Manager by the end of the season. Each Head Coach will be responsible for any equipment or keys not returned at the end of the season.
9. All correspondence with the League during the season will be done through Coaches' mailboxes and e-mails. Each coach will be responsible for checking their mailbox before each practice or game to distribute correspondence to their players.
10. All coaches will be responsible for having the fields ready for their scheduled games. This will entail dragging fields, and if necessary taking care of rain puddles, lining the fields and installing bases. Coaches are also responsible for contacting umpires and for cancelling games in a reasonable span of time. If this is not done, and the umpire shows for a

game that has been cancelled, the League will still have to pay the umpire.

11. Standing committees are permanent. These committees conduct business year-round. The Standing Committees of Conway Community League, Inc. are as follows: Concession Stand, Fundraising, and Field Manager.

12. The duties of the standing committees are as follows:

Field Manager Committee Chair

- a. Get the dirt.
- b. Clean up the fields.
- c. Make sure the field maintenance equipment works (i.e. battery and gas).
- d. Make sure there is lime and order it when it needs to be ordered.

Concession Stand Committee Chair

- a. Organize, coordinate and implement the schedule of workers for the season as well as the playoff games.
- b. Purchase the food, decide on what will be served and set the prices of the items.

Fund Raising Committee Chair

- a. Organize all future fundraisers and present them to the Board for approval.

13. If the Conway Community League, Inc. should fold for any reason, the monies left after securing all debts will be turned over to the Conway Recreation Committee.

14. Parents will be responsible for purchasing pants and socks (baseball) or shorts/pants and socks (softball) for their child before the first game of the season.

15. CCL parents will have precedence for coaching positions. If no one signs up to coach, we will look outside the league. If such a case happens, this individual MUST register to become a member of the league and will be charged a \$35 registration fee.
